The Parks & Recreation Advisory Board's mission for *Take Care of West Linn Day* is to promote the value of volunteerism and community pride by making available opportunities for community members to participate in projects to give back to their community and maintain the high quality of life in West Linn. The goal is to facilitate a large number of projects throughout the City led by community organizations or individuals. Individuals also have the opportunity to join one of these projects and provide an after-event to recognize volunteers.

Local organizations can choose to organize their own project or partner with another existing project. The Parks and Recreation Department will help with identifying a project and planning your project. There is also an opportunity to register yourself or family for an existing project.

In 2010 Take Care of West Linn Day had 18 different projects, located at 15 different sites, accomplished by 19 local groups.
