

The meeting was called to order at 7:15. Sandy Carter Exec. Dir. of the Willamette Falls Heritage Foundation gave us an update on what is happening in the Falls and Locks area. Roger Shepherd is the new president of this group. Al Lewis and Sandy are Bonneville Dam and Locks volunteers and are able to provide tours of the museum.

The gates inspection continues with minimal repair needed. In 2004-5 the organization looked for help in saving the locks and were accepted by Oregon Solutions --a Portland State entity that takes on non-controversial community projects. Two and a half years ago the Oregon City and West Linn mayors began to work on preservation of the area from the mouth of the Clackamas to the mouth of the Tualatin as a National Heritage Area. The Heritage area will include whatever the local community wants to accent.

Locks Fest will be September 19 if the locks will be open. The art show of Station A which has been in the library will move to Willamette Falls Hospital for the next 90 days. Al Lewis reminded that there is no charge for anyone to go through the locks. More info at willamette falls.org.

There was quite a lot of discussion regarding the Savannah Oaks issue. We voted that we all want to see the area preserved and we wanted to know more about the options available to make this happen.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved as printed.

The planting of the Firehouse roses for the new fire station will be Friday at 2 PM at the current fire station. All are welcome.

A W.L. Fair and Summer event meeting is the 11th at City Hall 6-8 PM.

Roger Shepherd discussed the May 16 "Take Care of W.L. Day" projects and we agreed that our Volunteer Garden would be a good Bolton project and that we would persue some funding for plants. Maddax Woods and McLean House are also doing projects and if you are not able to work on any of these it was suggested that you work together in your vicinity to spiff up what needs attention.
