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### **Police Station Steering Committee**

Recently, the Police Station Steering Committee has lost two of its original members: Thomas Frank will be joining the Council and Karen Hensley has too many conflicts and has had to resign. I've been asked to request that the Council appoint Jim Milne as a new member of the steering committee. Jim was appointed by the Willamette Neighborhood Association to serve on the design committee and has been actively involved with the project.

If the Council agrees with this recommendation, the Council can approve his appointment at your November 19 meeting under Business from the Council.

### **Work Session: Proposed Nuisance Ordinance**

The Mayor requested a copy of the noise complaint that was filed in August that has been discussed by a citizen during previous Council meetings. The Police Incident Report is attached for your information.

### **Transportation Improvement Grants**

On the Council agenda for November 19 is a resolution supporting the City's grant requests for transportation funding under the Enhance It grant program. The region is now beginning the review of projects to be funded through these grants from 2015 to 2018. The process is long and complex for a total of \$65 million anticipated for the entire Portland region for the four year period. Ultimately the Project Selection Committee (attached) will be making the final decisions.

Given the lack of funding region-wide, it is a tremendous challenge to have any of our projects funded, but the Council may wish to lobby members of the selection committee to assist in educating them to our needs. Staff can be available to assist Councilors with this effort.



It was clear the activity I witness from 2130 to 2200 violated this City Code.

In talking with the complainant it was clear this has been a long ongoing dispute. R/P told me the family living at the Kinsington address has been gone for about a month so there has been no problem. The R/P believes because he has complained in the past the family targets him. I asked what he meant by this. The R/P told me at times they will find as many as 5 balls in their backyard in one day from the Kinsington address. He explained they have had rocks thrown at the house, water balloons and back in June of this year a popsicle was thrown onto their back deck area which caused a permanent stain.


I seized the balls and other items as evidence:



Each of the balls has a date written on it regarding the date it ended up in the R/P's yard. The bag of water balloons also had a date. The large balls were deflated to make them easier to place into evidence.

Based on my observations of the noise, the fact HOLMES has been cited before and clearly knows the rules I decided to issue a citation. I contacted Mr. HOLMES at his residence and asked him to come outside and talk with me. I explained to Mr. HOLMES why I was there. HOLMES told me he gets home at 6pm most days and often his 5 kids want to play. He does not believe he should have to stop playing with his kids at 7pm.

I told him I understood his point but that did not change the fact the City Code was clear about the time. HOLMES admitted he knew about the 7pm time frame. I showed HOLMES all the balls I took as evidence from the R/P. I talked to him about the rocks and water balloons. HOLMES assured me he would discipline his kids if he knew they were throwing those types of items at the neighbors. I told him I believed him but I also believed it was happening.

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I issued HOLMES the citation and he said, "So I have to go see Heather again?" I told him he would have to see the City of West Linn Municipal Court Judge.

I told HOLMES that although I understood him being upset at the neighbors for complaining about him playing with his children I also understood their point. I told him it would be impossible for me to sleep in the R/P's bedroom with the amount of noise he and his children were making. I explained that he may not agree with the 7pm restriction on this type of noise but the fact still remained it is the law in West Linn.

HOLMES was upset but cooperative.
