### Future Meetings:

- **April 28:** The City Council will meet at 5:30 on Monday night (April 28) to tour the new police station which is currently under construction. The construction is expected to be completed by the end of August.
- **May 5:** This work session will include an update from the Stafford Hamlet and a discussion of the proposed Water Resource Area Amendments to the Community Development Code. The Council will also be reviewing the agenda for the May 12 meeting. As part of that agenda, staff will be requesting Council approval for a new financial software system. This will mark the culmination of several years of review to identify an appropriate vendor and ensure that we have the tools and resources for implementation.
- **May 12:** The main item on the agenda for May 12 will be the regulatory streamlining package. We are anticipating that the Council will take testimony that evening and close the public hearing. The Council will then reconvene one week later (May 19) for final consideration of the proposal.

### Tanner Creek Park

This week, installation of solar panels began on the shelter at Tanner Creek Park. This is a joint project of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and the Sustainability Advisory Committee. The solar panels are recommended in the Sustainable West Linn Plan.

### House at Fields Bridge Park

At the last Council work session, the Council asked about the status of the deconstruction of the house at Fields Bridge park. Parks and Recreation Director Ken Worcester informs me that the house cannot be deconstructed until the new pacers are installed. It should be down by the end of May.
