It has come to my attention that there will not be a quorum of the City Council for meetings on either March 9 or March 16. Therefore, I believe it makes the most sense to hold the Council's regular March meeting on March 23.

The March Council meeting schedule would look like this:

March 2: Council work session. Agenda items include a presentation from Clackamas County Water Environment Services staff regarding the Tri City Service District; HB 2800 that also relates to the Tri City Service District; and the Robinwood Station's conditional use permit application. (I have also added an executive session for 5:30 that evening to discuss collective bargaining.)

March 9: Regular Meeting -- postponed until March 23

March 16: Work Session --- cancelled

March 23: City Council Regular Meeting. I would expect a relatively light agenda and would like to include a joint meeting with the Planning Commission to discuss the Economic Opportunities Analysis and the Arch Bridge Concept Plan.

March 30: No meeting -- fifth Monday of the month.

Also, the City Council needs to determine how it wants to respond to Clackamas County's offer of mediation on the issue of the urban reserve designation for the Stafford area.
