West Linn Slurry Seal Work

The City of West Linn will apply slurry seals to West Linn streets from June 22 to June 26, 2009.

A slurry seal is a versatile and cost effective way to protect pavement; the seal is a graded aggregate applied to the roadway with emulsion and water.

During the days of slurry seal application, streets will be closed temporarily to driving until all barricades are removed.



This time period usually lasts between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

The streets will only be opened when the barricades are removed entirely by the West Linn Streets

department. Drivers should be aware that new slurry seal applications require time to cure. The curing stage of slurry seals lasts for three to four hours during which the streets will be closed following application.

Residents are urged to drive carefully for a few weeks after the streets are opened for traffic as the surface can be damaged by heavy vehicles until it is fully cured.

- River Street from Holly Street to Bella Street
- Valley View Drive from Suncrest Drive to View Court
- Grant Street from Sunset Avenue to Charman Street
