West Linn Clean Up Day

The City of West Linn invites you to join in community clean up and recycling. On September 26, 2009, the City will host a free clean up day featuring Goodwill drop off sites and dumpsters at six locations in West Linn.

This event is free to West Linn residents. You can donate your reusables to Goodwill and dump your trash that cannot be donated to Goodwill. The sale of donated goods in Goodwill's retail and outlet stores generates revenue for Goodwill which allows them to serve thousands Oregonians annually. Goodwill recycles all computer equipment, laptops, monitors, and TVs free of charge.

Any items that are not accepted by Goodwill can be dumped in the provided trash bins on a first come, first serve basis. Also on the 26th, you are invited to participate in two clean up service projects at Mary S. Young Park and the McLean House. The Mary S. Young Park project volunteers will help remove invasive species from the park. McLean House volunteers will work on indoor and outdoor projects.
