The City of West Linn invites you to join in community clean up and recycling. On September 18, 2010, the City will host a free clean up day featuring Goodwill drop off sites and dumpsters at five West Linn locations.

This event is free to West Linn residents. You can donate your reusables to Goodwill and dump your trash that cannot be donated to Goodwill. The sale of donated goods in Goodwill's retail and outlet stores generates revenue for Goodwill which allows them to serve thousands of Oregonians annually. Goodwill recycles all computer equipment, laptops, monitors, and TVs free of charge.

Any items that are not accepted by Goodwill can be dumped in the provided trash bins on a first come, first serve basis. Also on the 18th, you are invited to participate in a clean up service projects at Mary S. Young Park. The Mary S. Young Park project volunteers will help remove invasive species from the park.



Speed Zone Change to 25 MPH

The speed zone on Rosemont Road from Oppenlander Sports Field to Furlong Drive in the City of West Linn will decrease from 35 MPH to 25 MPH on August 25, 2010.

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) authorized this change after completing a study jointly requested by the City of West Linn and the Rosemont Summit Neighborhood Association. ODOT justifies the need for this change based upon citizen's concerns for pedestrian safety (adjacent to a middle school), the presence of a school zone, speed zone inconsistency with other nearby zones, and the presence of a four-way stop intersection.

Motorists are encouraged to slow down and observe the new speed zone.
