# **Council Authorizes Acquisition of New Trail Access to Mary S. Young from Mapleton Drive**

At the Monday, February 4, 2013 meeting, the West Linn City Council unanimously authorized the property acquisition 3.06 acres located at 4600 Mapleton Drive. This property will allow for new trail access to Mary S. Young Park from Mapleton Drive. This is a foreclosure property offered to the City for purchase by Clackamas County. The purchase price of \$47,533 represents the back taxes owed on the property, plus administrative costs.

Parks & Recreation Director Ken Worcester advised the City Council that the price per acre for this Mapleton Drive property was a prudent financial decision. Funds are budgeted and available from the Parks SDC fund. The budgeted cost of open space in West Linn is \$150,000 per acre; this property acquisition allows for West Linn to obtain open space for approximately \$15,000 per acre. Ronn McFarlane was a faculty member of the Peabody Conservatory from 1984 to 1995, teaching lute and lute-related subjects. In 1996, Mr. McFarlane was awarded an honorary

Doctorate of Music from Shenandoah Conservatory for his achievements in bringing the lute and its music to the world.

He has over 25 recordings on the Dorian label, including solo albums, lute songs, recordings with the Baltimore Consort, and Blame Not My Lute, a collection of Elizabethan lute music and poetry, with spoken word by Robert Aubry Davis.

Ronn McFarlane is one of the most outstanding lutenists performing today, and is largely responsible for bringing the transcendent charm and timeless quality of the lute into the musical mainstream.

# Fix a Leak Week is March 18-22, 2013

Even the smallest water leak or drip can waste large amounts of water, which can add up to wasting money. Check your lawn irrigation systems. Before turning on your outside irrigation system for the summer, here are a few things you can do to check for leaks and ensure water efficient performance throughout the year.

- Close all manual drains the sprinkler system was probably drained last fall in preparation for the winter – make sure that none of the manual drain valves have been left open.
- Slowly open the main valve and allow the mainline piping from the main valve to the backflow prevention to fill with water.
- Have the backflow prevention assembly tested by a state certified tester.

The Clackamas River Water Providers have a rebate for up to \$25.00 if you purchase a rain sensor switch which will temporarily shut off your irrigation system when it rains. Visit this website for more information: ClackamasProviders.org
