The West Linn Public Library holds a series of musical concerts called "Music in the Stacks." The library is looking for engaging, lively, family-friendly performers who can perform for a wide range of audience members.

The concerts are held in the library's Reading Room, with audiences ranging from 25-50 people. Your entire group will have a 10' x 15' area of performance space with six electrical outlets available. (See photos of the performance area on the next page.) Please note that due to the size of the space, amplification is usually not necessary. The library does not have a piano.

Concerts will be held the third Wednesday of the month (except where it conflicts with a holiday). Our concerts are free and open to the public. We occasionally need to distribute a limited number of free tickets if exceptionally high attendance is expected. Payment is made to performers at time of service.

We are currently booking performers for September 2014 through May 2015. Your application must be submitted by 6 p.m. on Wednesday, May 28.




