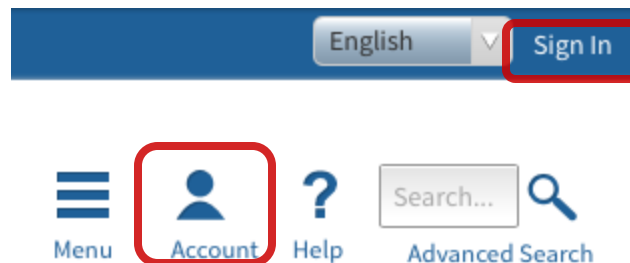

Sign In



- On your computer go to library2go.lib.overdrive.com
- It's a good idea to sign in before you search so that you see books only available to Clackamas County patrons.
- Click the **Sign In** link in the upper right corner or the **Account** button.

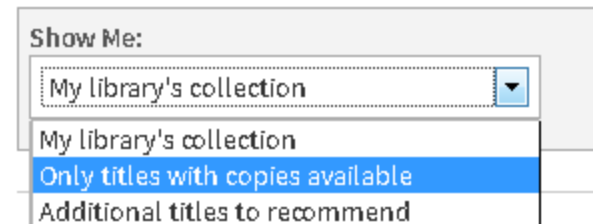

- When looking at the list of titles you can further narrow your results using the filters on the left side of the page.
- NOTE: You may want to apply the Kindle Book filter since that is the only format that will work with your Kindle.

Narrowing Your Results, cont.



- By default you will see all titles that match your criteria. To see only the books that are available for checkout right now, choose **Only titles with copies available** from the Show Me drop-down menu.



Placing a Hold



- If all copies of a book are checked out, you can put a hold on the book. Tap the **Place Hold** button.

Checking Out



- Watch for ebooks published by Penguin, which can ONLY be transferred to your Kindle via USB cable from your computer.

Checking Out



- When you find a book you want to check out, tap the **Borrow** button.
- If you are not already signed in to your account you will be prompted to do so.

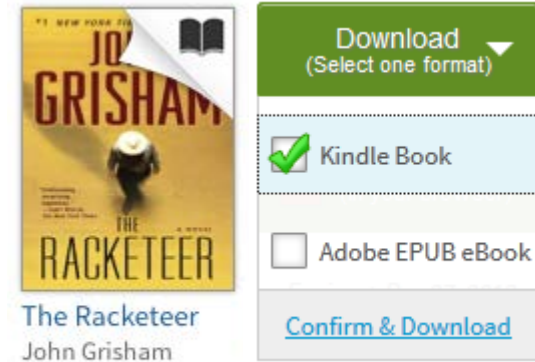

- Tap the **Download** button then choose the **Kindle Book** format.
- Tap the **Confirm & Download** link.



Checking Out



- You will be taken to the Amazon website. Make sure you are logged in with the same account that your Kindle is registered with.
- Click the **Get Library Book** button.



Wi-Fi Transfer



- You will be notified that the book has been sent to the specified device.

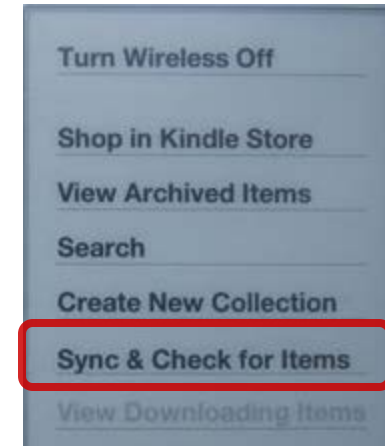

Wi-Fi Transfer



- To transfer the ebook to your Kindle via wi-fi make sure your Kindle is connected to a wi-fi network
- Select the **Sync** function.
- The ebook will now download.



USB Transfer



- If your Kindle does not support Wi-Fi transfers, or if the ebook is published by Penguin, you will need to transfer the book to your Kindle manually.
- To begin a manual transfer, click the **Download now** button.

WLPL Kindle 1 does not support Wi-Fi. Wi-Fi is required for wireless delivery of public library books. You can download **Rage: A Love Story** now and transfer the file from your computer via USB. ([Learn more](#))



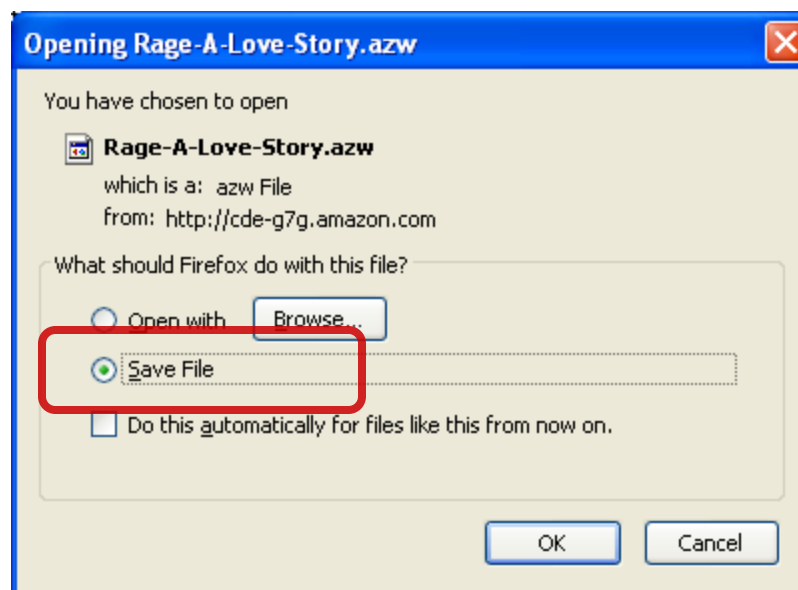

USB Transfer



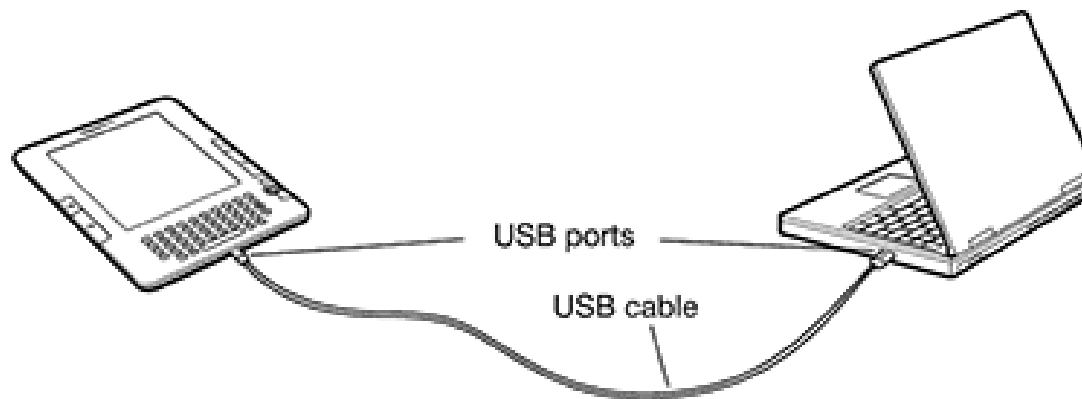
- When prompted, save the Kindle ebook (it should be saved to your default download folder).



USB Transfer



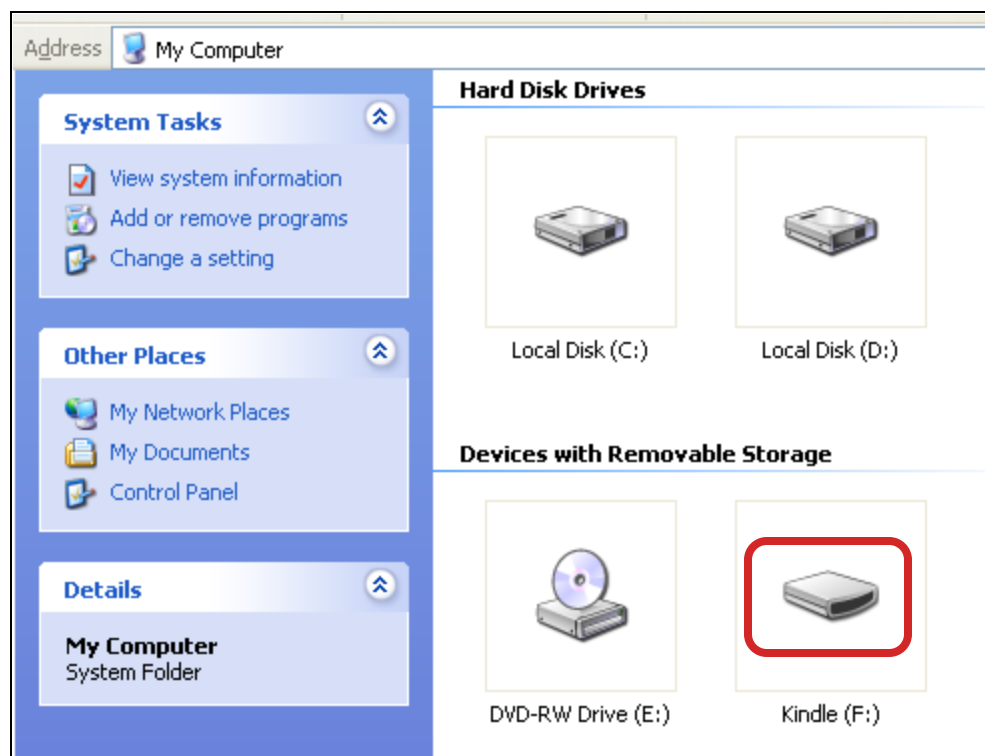
- Plug your Kindle into your computer's USB port.



USB Transfer



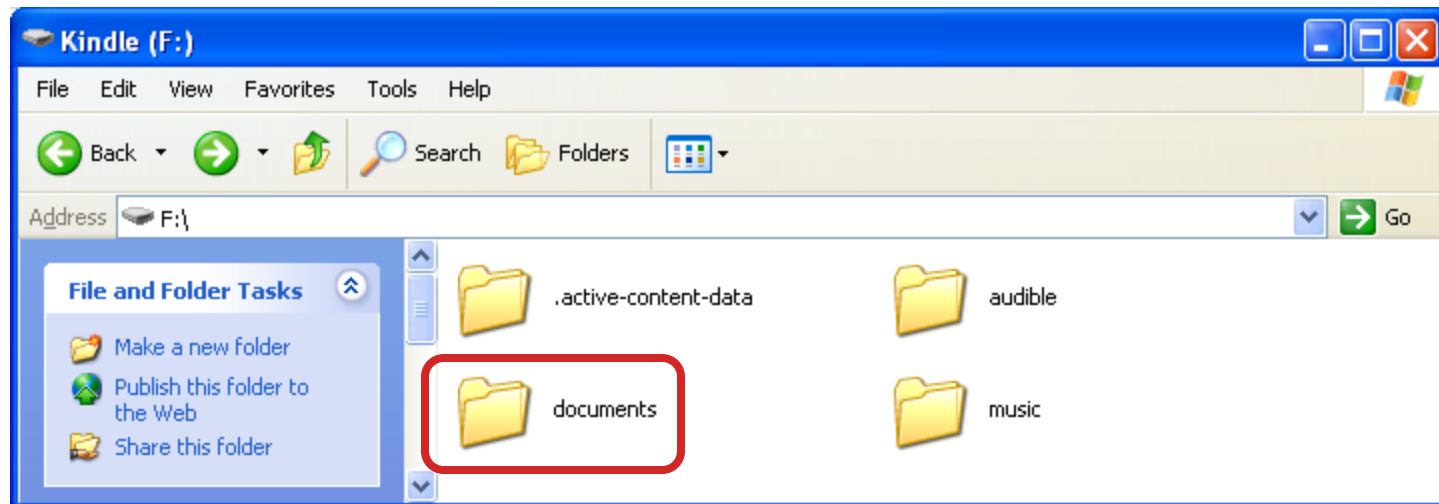
- Your Kindle should show up as a separate drive in your computer's file browser. Double-click the icon to open it.



USB Transfer



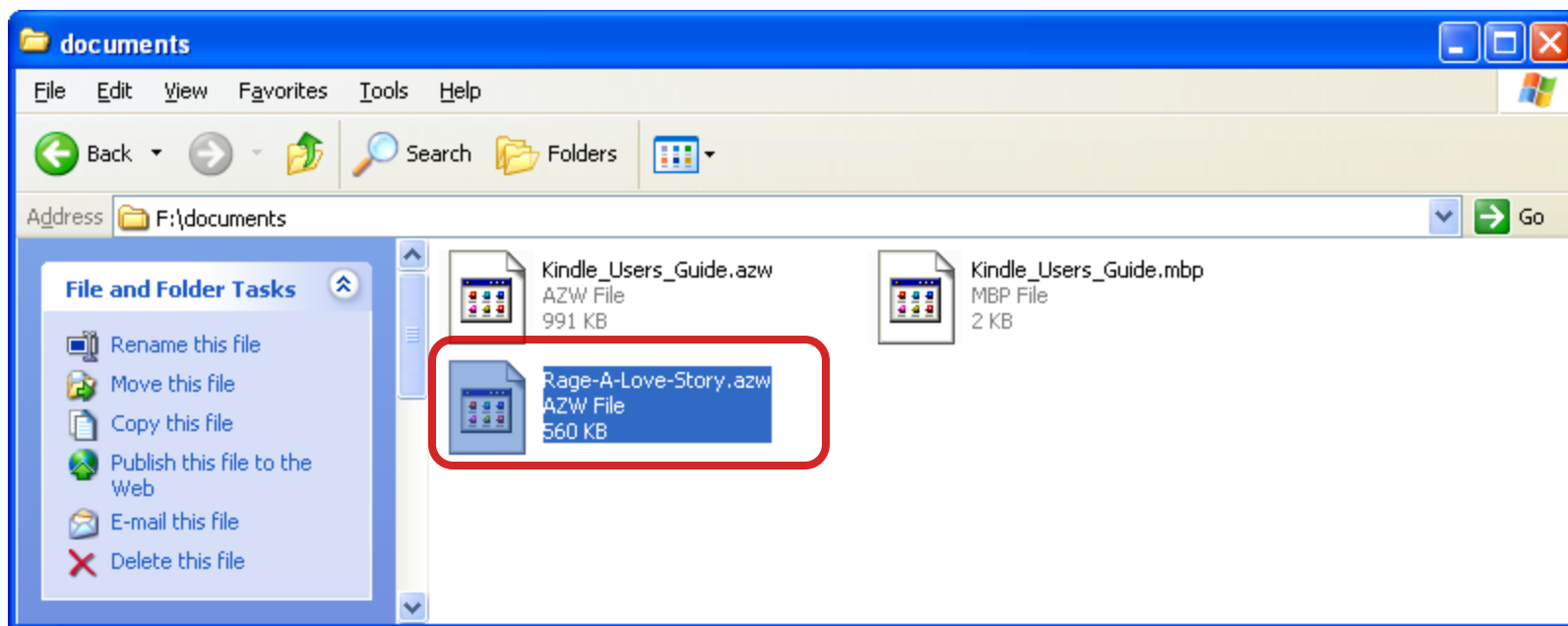
- Open the **documents** folder.



USB Transfer



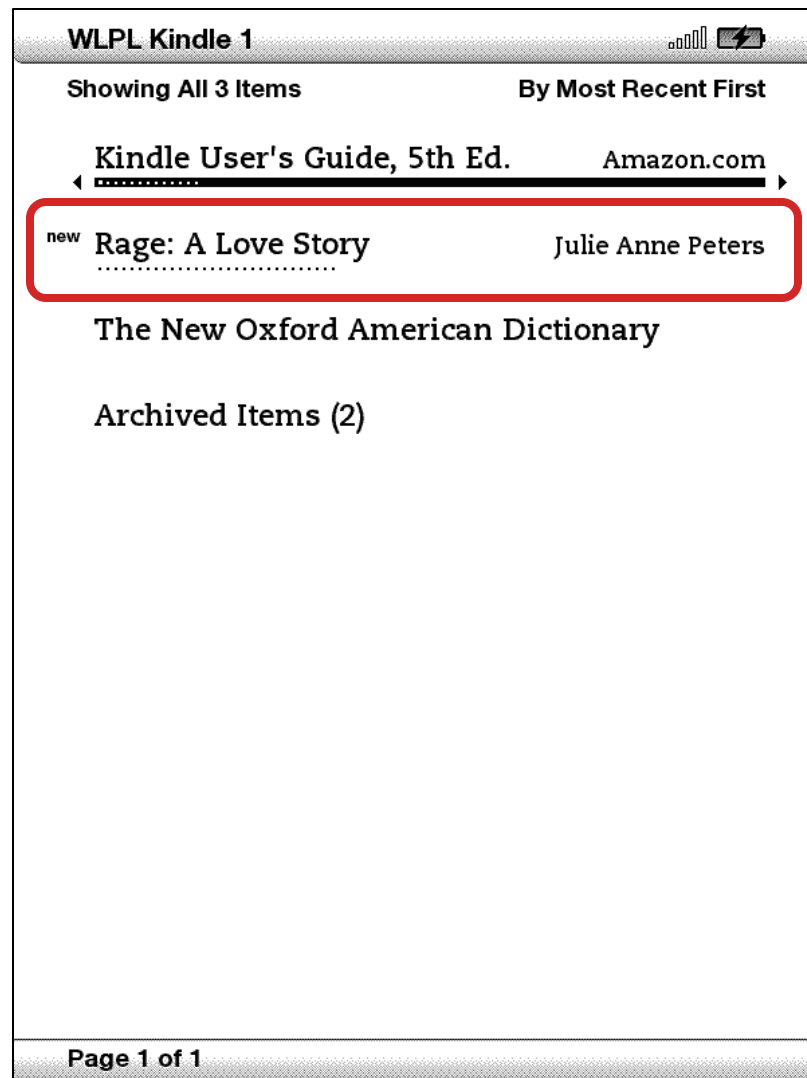
- Copy the downloaded Kindle book into the **documents** folder.



USB Transfer



- Eject the Kindle from your computer. The transferred book is ready to be read!



Returning Kindle Books Early



- On Amazon.com go the **Manage Your Kindle** section, then choose **Return this book** under the **Actions** menu for the book.
- Tap **Yes** to finish the return process.
