

# Instructions for checking out and reading digital magazines



1. On your computer or mobile device open your browser and go to [www.lincc.org](http://www.lincc.org), click [Online Resources](#), click [Resources for West Linn](#), then click [Zinio](#).
2. Login with your library card number and PIN (which is usually the last four digits of your phone number).
3. Search for a magazine title in the search box or browse through the collection.
4. Click the cover for the magazine you wish to check out.
5. Click the blue **Checkout** button.
6. If you have previously created a Zinio account, enter your email and password and click the blue **Log in** button. If you are a new user, click the [Create New Account](#) link.
7. If you are on a computer you can read the magazine in your browser. Click the blue **Start Reading** button and the magazine will open in a new tab.

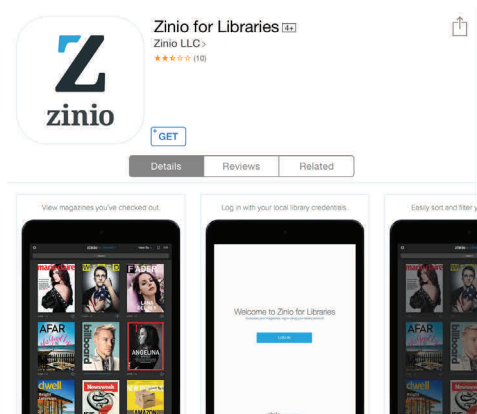

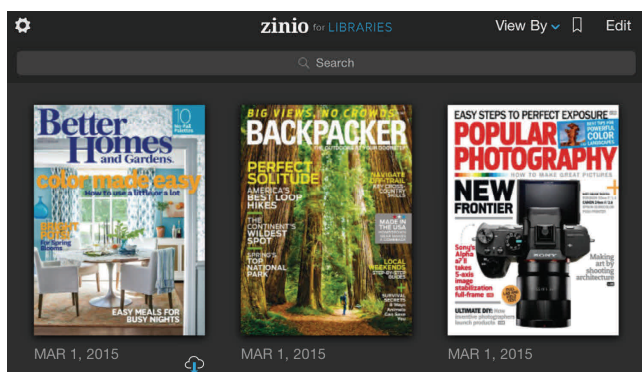

8. If you are on a mobile device you can read the magazine in the **Zinio for Libraries** app, which is available in the App Store (Apple) and the Play Store (Android).

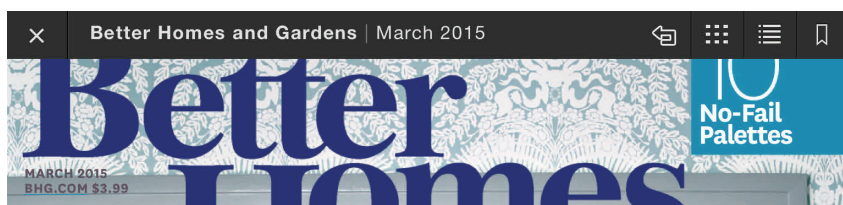


9. Open the app and log in with your Zinio account. Any magazines you have checked out will now be displayed. To download them for offline reading on your device tap the download button.

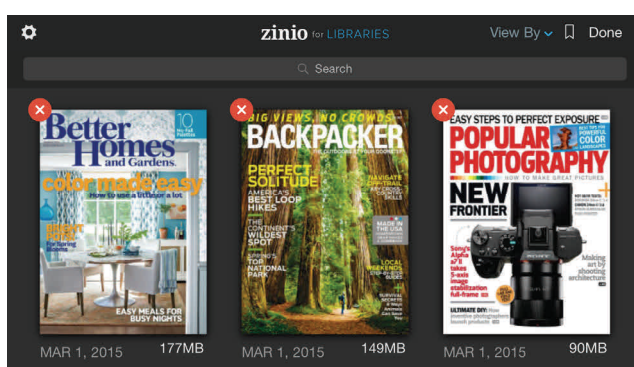
10. If new checkouts are not displaying in the app, tap the **Settings** button in the upper left corner then tap **Sync Library**.



11. To read a magazine tap its cover. Turn the pages by swiping left or right. Access the table of contents and other options by tapping at the very top or very bottom of the screen. Get back to the main screen by tapping the X in the upper left corner.



12. To free up space on your device you can delete magazines. From the main screen of the app tap **Edit** in the upper right corner, then tap the red X on the magazine you want to delete. Then tap **Done**.



## Notes

- The app is for **reading only**. You cannot search the library's collection or check out from the app.
- Zinio magazines never have a due date. They are yours to keep.
- If you previously installed the commercial Zinio app you can delete it.
