- 1. Call to Order – by Jef Treece, MNA President**
- 2. Minutes from July 23, 2013 Meeting were approved.**
- 3. Treasurer’s Report by Jim Koll, MNA Treasurer \$5,448.03**
- 4. Old Business**
 - a. Land Use Pre-applications - Karie Oakes said that none are pending and then explained the process when there is an issue.**
