**REGULAR MEETING
CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Petersen called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. in the Bolton Room of City Hall, 22500 Salamo Road, West Linn, Oregon.

BUSINESS MEETING

Mr. Mattis made a motion to approve the 2/17/15 minutes. Ms. Lewis seconded the motion. The motion passed 4:0:1.

Ms. Javoronok outlined that she prepared two PowerPoint presentations for the evening's discussion, the first on historic resources and architecture in West Linn and the second with photos of various homes and architectural styles submitted by the HRB members. The first PowerPoint outlined the local and National Register historic district boundaries, the historic landmarks, and other historic properties in West Linn. Ms. Javoronok also outlined the historic resources surveys completed and the survey forms available from the Oregon Historic Sites Database and the City's database. She outlined the pertinent local regulations in the City's code and their location in the Community Development Code and Municipal Code. The presentation then outlined the various architectural styles in the historic district and those of the historic landmarks. The most popular styles in the historic district are Queen Anne and bungalow. The historic landmarks also include Mediterranean Revival, Colonial Revival, Tudor Revival, institutional, and multifamily uses.

Staff and the HRB reviewed the photos submitted. It included photos of the historic district, older and newer properties in the area, and others around the West with unique architectural elements.

BUSINESS FROM THE HISTORIC REVIEW BOARD


Mr. Mattis and staff did not have substantive updates on the ongoing preservation related projects.
