1. Question: Who will be performing the asphalt testing, the City or the Contractor?

Answer: Contractor

2. Question: What is the maximum duration between grinding and paving?

Answer: The first layer of paving shall be placed within 5 working days of pavement removal (milling) operations on all City streets. Failure to begin paving within this time frame will result in the assessment of liquidated damages. *This note will be added to the general notes, no addendum will be issued to the plan set*

3. Question: In the sections where a full 3-inch grind is required, would the City have coring logs available?

Answer: The coring was performed by City staff and no log was kept. However, each pavement section was designed according to the depth of the core sample with the intention of avoiding grinding into the aggregate base material. In a situation where the contractor may disturb the aggregate base material, City Staff will be available to regrade the base material.

4. Question: Who will be handling the public notifications?

Answer: City Staff will take care of the public notifications

5. Question: Detail D5 on sheet D1.3, calls out Sawcut Line. Can the contractor use a small grinder in this situation versus a sawcut?

Answer: Yes, if the small grinder produces the same vertical edge that a sawcut would. The City inspector will verify.

6. Question: Will the City allow detours?

Answer: Per 26h in the General Terms and Conditions: No street within this project may be closed to through traffic or to local emergency traffic without the prior written approval of the City Engineer per direction of the City Manager of the City of West Linn. 26h also states that written approval may be granted if sufficient time exists to allow for notification of the public at least two (2) days in advance of such closing.
