ITEM NO. 1 – BID DESCRIPTION, SECOND PARAGRAPH:

The statement:

“The contract is for a public work subject to prevailing wage law ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870.” is hereby changed to read:

“The contract is for a public work **which may be** subject to prevailing wage law ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870.

ITEM NO. 2 – BID DESCRIPTION, THIRD PARAGRAPH:

The paragraph should be replaced in total with the following:

“Work generally consists of the application of pavement crack preparatory work followed by application of approved crack sealing compound on identified sections of West Linn streets. Contract is a unit price contract; bid is the amount total cost to crack sealing all the lineal footage of cracks as shown on the 2012 Crack Sealing List. The total cost of crack sealing shall not be equal to or exceed \$50,000. If the contractor cost equals or exceeds \$50,000, the contractor will be subject to BOLI Prevailing Wages without any increase to the unit cost submitted in his bid. Project shall include that work necessary to perform cleaning, traffic control, placing crack sealing material, and other incidental work in order to crack seal the designated project streets. The contract work must be completed within two (2) months following award; however once work is commenced on site, all work must be completed and accepted within thirty (30) days. The prioritized list of streets to be crack sealed is attached labeled 2012 Crack Sealing. The estimated unit quantity upon which the bidder’s unit price is based may vary by a maximum of 20% without triggering renegotiation of the unit price.

ITEM NO. 3 – REPLACEMENT (REVISED) BID SHEET (ATTACHED)

Use the attached Bid Sheet in preparing and submitting the bid.

ITEM NO. 4 – PREVAILING WAGE

If the contract price exceeds \$50,000 and this Contract is not otherwise exempt, workers shall be paid not less than the specified minimum hourly rate of wage in accordance with ORS 279C.838 and ORS 279C.840. The applicable prevailing wage rates may be accessed via that internet at: http://www.oregon.gov/BOLI/WHD/PWR/pwr_book.shtml. Hard copies of the prevailing wage rates publication may be obtained by contacting the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries via telephone at: (971) 673-0839. If this Project is subject to the Davis-Bacon Act and the state

prevailing rate of wage is higher than the federal prevailing rate of wage, the contractor and every subcontractor on the Project shall pay at least the state prevailing rate of wage as determined under ORS 279C.815.

The Contractor must have a public works bond filed with the Oregon Construction Contractors Board before starting work on the Project, unless exempt under ORS 279C.836 (4), (7), (8) or (9). The Contractor shall pay the applicable prevailing wage rates that are in effect at the time Owner enters into this Construction Contract with Contractor.

For contracts \$50,000 or greater, City shall pay a fee to the Bureau of Labor and Industries and shall be mailed or otherwise delivered to the Bureau at the following address:
