Updates:

Robinwood Station Randall Fastabend - Operational Business Plan submitted to city.

Community Garden Looking for new members next year for \$20 and 40 hours of work.

Committee and Community Reports:

Parks - Don Kingsborough - Kayak locker going up at Willamette Park. Robinwood Boat Ramp construction window closing for this season. \$385,000 required to complete funding for ACC expansion and upgrade. Bikes to be allowed on Rosemont Family Trail.

Public Works - LOT proceeding with pipeline on Mapleton and Hwy 43 right after election. Reservoir Alternative Siting Study available, to be discussed 11/14 Council Work Session.

Community Development - No current Pre-Apps in Robinwood.

Old Business:

Upper Midhill Development - Andrew Tull of 3J Consulting had no new information or a timeframe. Ole had questions about the history of the current zoning. Bob Stowell was on City Council during rezoning in 1985. Plat was to have one to three street connections to LO. Tina Decker introduced a motion to oppose development under the current 34 unit limit. Resolution to be taken up at the November RNA meeting.
