

Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting

Minutes

The meeting was called to order by SONA Vice President Ken Pryor at 7:00 PM.

There were four regular SONA members and two guests in attendance.

Minutes from the May meeting were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote.

There was no Treasurer report but Mr. Pryor made note of the fact that no funds were expended since the last report so the bank balance of \$1,636.65 should be the same.

Old Business

Teri Cummings updated the West Linn city proposed “Regulatory Streaming” project. We were advised that none of the May 6th Resolution items submitted to City Council by SONA were included. In summary, the Council passed all of the city proposed changes including “de novo” and the “Two Person Call Up Rule”.

New Business

Mr. Piseth Pich, Public Affairs Officer of Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue (TVFR), gave the group insight concerning the functions and duties of TVFR. Our local station serves the community with 5 to 6 calls per day many of them medical related. The station is staffed round the clock with a four-man crew and the crew on standby was called in for introduction. Training and preparation is key to the success of this vital function.

The follow-up question and answer session was most informative. The group was provided with useful handouts including the “Red” medical emergency information cards meant to be posted on the refrigerator for first responders and a multi page advisor for emergency preparedness. Advice was given regarding the upcoming “illegal fireworks” issue (this is a police item).

Nominations for officers were not considered due to time constraints and the limited number of members in attendance.

The meeting adjourned at 8:40 PM.
