There will be a Thank You BBQ at the Savanna on Saturday June 27 from noon to 2 pm to show appreciation to the community for over 10,500 hours of volunteer work at the Savanna. Also, 220 sixth graders from Athey Creek Middle School are going to do restoration volunteer work at the Savanna on June 5.

New Business:

- 1. Councilor Thomas Frank cancelled his scheduled appearance and discussion at the SONA meeting.
- 2. ConAm's request to present to SONA at the July 7 meeting was discussed. The written request to make a presentation describes a Design Review application for "about 210 multiple-family units above the first floor of the structures with commercial development located on the first floor of the structures, as provided for in CDC 21.050.2."
- 3. "Next door" was discussed. Individual resident participation is voluntary.
- 4. This year's SONA Ice Cream Social was planned and the budget, not to exceed \$300, was approved with a unanimous vote
- 5. A postcard will be mailed to SONA residents to advise them of the upcoming Ice Cream Social on July 12 from 1 to 3 pm at Douglas Park and the Thank You BBQ on June 27 from 12 noon to 2 pm.
