#### **GUEST PRESENTATIONS**

- 1. West Linn Police Officer Kempas: Officer Kempas reported that the main problem in West Linn at this time is cars being broken into, primarily because car doors being left unlocked and valuables in plain sight. - 2. City of West Linn Trails Master Plan update: Todd Jones, West Linn Park and Recreation Advisory Board member, spoke about the proposed trail just north of I-205. This trail will run from the intersection of 10<sup>th</sup> street and Salamo east to Imperial Drive, paralleling I-205. Some of the residents in the Barrington Heights neighborhood were concerned about having a trail so close to their properties: increase crime, potential for fire. Therefore, the trail was moved closer to I-205. In addition, it was mentioned that the trail would in fact serve as a fire line to prevent flames from going up the bank. The trail would allow walkers, strollers, and bicyclers, and would connect the Willamette and Sunset neighborhoods. - 3. Sunset Neighborhood Plan Implementation:
  - **Increasing Involvement by our neighbors:** As previously reported the picnic took place on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2013.
  - **Sunset School:** The city has vacated the right-of-way which will allow the school to access Sunset Park property. The school has constructed a fence around their new portion of the park.
  - **Preserving our natural resources survey of trees and vistas:** Rob Cozzi and Troy Bowers met with the city. *No update*.
  - **Preservation of historic resources:** Shawn Hughes has volunteered to head this up. *No update*.
  - Assessing safety needs survey of sidewalks, pathways, and trails: The city reported to Doug Vokes that they do not have funding for the Summit/Oxford intersection pathway, however it will be put on their list of priorities. The city did add traffic reflectors at the intersection.
  - Enhancing the SN identity intersection signs: Troy Bowers and Tony Breault are working on this. *No update*.

## 4. 2009/2010 Goals Update:

- 1. Rezoning of properties at Sunset and Cornwall from general commercial to neighborhood commercial. *No update*.
- 2. Work with City and Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) to determine how to best manage overall Sunset/Cornwall/Lancaster/Parker alignment. *No update*.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- **1. Elections of Officers:** Anthony (Tony) Breault, President, Randall Jahnson, Vice President, Doreen Vokes, Sec/Treas. Were elected unanimously (9 0).
- **2.** Trails Master Plan: Todd Jones asked us to pass a motion to endorse the I-205 Trail in concept only. *A motion was seconded and passed unanimously*.
