

Presidents Meeting recurring items:

- Tolling of Interstate 5-this is a law that was passed by the legislature. From Stafford over the Abernathy Bridge. Starting to stage.
- City ordered 2 electric Rivian Trucks.
- ODOT reached an agreement on the water line.
- Federal infrastructure money-where is it going?
- Oregon Financial Portfolio Managers are incentivized.
- Public Works Project
- Oppenlander Field – 3.5 million-school district surplused the property, developer offered 6.5 million. Word leaked. District and City entered into a contract that there would be an independent appraisal of the property and both parties agree to that number. City has first right of refusal. Ridiculously low 120,000. Bond measure to fund a 3.5 million dollar amount. This will be on the May ballot.
- Round about at the bridge Willamette Falls before the bridge with an entrance to the new school.
- Cornwall Development was approved with stipulations. Icon has submitted the redesign and it has been approved without neighborhood involvement.
 - Landis will go up and there will be a hammerhead street 25 feet wide, only 15 feet paved.
 - ICON installing water line
 - City installing sewer line
 - If current septic goes bad they will have to connect to sewer.
 - The homeowners have an opportunity at any planning commission meeting or the city council meeting and give public testimony. Goes on official public record. You can also submit in writing. We need to get them to hear about changes to the pathway, that has now dropped off the plan.
 - No follow through on bond that was approved.
 - No follow through on rain gardens, they will only be inspected when installed, they won't have continuous oversight.
- City parks doesn't have the staff to maintain the parks. They added two park maintenance employees.
- Street lights (Jeff Randall)-in particular Barrington Heights. Can't be replaced if damaged or need replacing. Over 1 million to replace all, or maintain what is left and figure out how to replace what is missing. Bucket truck waiting for a part.
- Sidewalk repair-city committed to replacing trees, sidewalks, city was supposed to survey the neighborhood and prioritize the city commitments. City needs to do one of two things:
 1. Say they are working on a funding source, or

2. The code says they have to replace trees and sidewalks.
