Library Update: Doug Erickson, Director of Library & Community Services: Doug was happy to announce that Rachael Hyde will be representing the West Linn Library as the LDAC Representative.

- Library Updates & programs:
 - Story Walk- With the generosity of the West Linn Library Foundation, the Library will be installing a Story Walk at one of the Parks in West Linn. A Story Walk is a fun, educational activity that places a children's story (literally a book taken apart) along a popular walking route in your community. The library is looking to install at Field's Bridge Park, but no final decision has been made. The library would like to thank the Holly Grace Jones Endowment for their generosity & funding this project.
 - Tales to Tails- We are excited to announce our reading program for kids to read with dogs is starting up in May. Traditionally the program takes a break over the Summer. Otto the Library Dog will be retiring after 7 years of good deeds at the library. Booker, Otto's brother will be stepping in to participate in the Tales to Tails program. Booker & Melanie

will be attending their Pet Partner's Team exam this weekend. Booker will then be a registered Therapy dog like Otto.

- Adult Programs- Doug & Rick reported on two new Adult programming- Adult Book Club bundles & Adult Writing class with Ellen Santasiero, both programs are sponsored by the West Linn Library Foundation.
- Juneteenth Celebration-is now a Federal, State & City Holiday. The City of West Linn will be hosting a celebration Juneteenth on Sunday, June 19th. The City offices & buildings will be closed on Monday, June 20th to observe the holiday.
- Discussion of updated Library Strategic Goals- The updated layout for strategic goals 2022-2024 was passed out. A digital copy was emailed to virtual attendees
- Decision of date, times & frequency- After a few discussions over the last few meetings. It was agreed on that it was best for the Library Advisory Board members meet on the THIRD TUESDAY of the month.
