Agenda Topic 5 – Tree Planting Program Overview

Summary New tree planting program from the city

Discussion Jerry, city has lobbyist to cover these programs. Our congressional staffers that liaise from federal reps are good for city participation in these programs. The recent email from John Williams talked about the last council meeting with \$200k from the American Rescue Plan for

	<p>tree planting. The trees available for \$200 (size and type) will be determined by city arborist (on short list of what will do well). Total cost of lost trees includes sidewalk repair, stump removal, tree planting, and labor. Not enough money to fully fund. A community communications person to relay program. Approx. 2,400 trees lost here ID via GIS system (captured by city staff). Street tree replacements where it hasn't been done already.</p> <p>Tree plantings will happen in fall and spring. For equitable outcomes, what are the impacts to underserved or disadvantaged? The cost may be an issue for pruning and establishment. How do we make sure trees are allocated equitably in the city?</p> <p>Jerry not aware of what our current city tree canopy data is. In 2009 the data showed at 38% tree canopy in West Linn. City of Milwaukie has a tree canopy goal of 40%. There was a lot of tree loss with natural loss, development, and the ice storm. It would be good to have an understanding of the broad goal.</p> <p>Council meeting in September will bring up canopy goal.</p>
