#### **Old Business and Updates:**

• Skyline Circle and Skyline Drive Members: Ongoing City "due process" to finalize the approval.

- **Permanent solution to Willamette River Noise:** Bob (Robert) reported that July 20<sup>th</sup> is the last day to request verbal testimony to Oregon Marine Board on the July 28<sup>th</sup> re: "Petition to Amend Rule Pertaining to Watercraft Noise." Bob, as President of Bolton NA, has submitted and received confirmation from OMB for verbal testimony. <a href="mailto:osamb.rulemaking@boat.oregon.gov">osamb.rulemaking@boat.oregon.gov</a>
- <u>ODOT: Abernethy Bridge Update:</u> Beth, ODOT and Kent Bodin, Kiewit Construction gave updates on construction for the new bridge. The pile driving activities has been delayed and will start mid next week and noise will be heard. As described by ODOT: "within 200' the pile driving sound will be comparable to a noisy restaurant. At 500' and greater from pile driving, the sound will be no louder than city traffic." Ground pile driving will continue the rest of the year. It was also noted that on August 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, there will be night time lane closures on I 205; 2 lanes will stay open 1 north and 1 south bound. The estimated completion time of the bridge is 10/30/2025. The construction of the bridge was described as similar to the Sellwood Bridge.
