- **City Communications:** Community members are interested in building better communications with the city. At the neighborhood associations presidents meeting they discussed better methods of communication with the city. Our group would like a request to the city to get a list of specific changes they plan on making and changes they commit to make.
- **Housing Strategies**: Invite Darren Wyss to discuss housing strategies in West Linn. We would like to have a better understanding about new building rules including things like exceptions, taxes, tax exemptions, and parking associated with structures like ADU's.

New Business:

• Christi Lanz Running for School Board: Christi Lanz has made the decision to run for School Board in the May 20 election. Over the past 6 months, she has invested her time focusing on communities concerns about WLWV budget issues and working on innovative solutions to keep our schools open and kept the community engaged. She was instrumental in making sure the board listened to the public's concerns and talked about other options besides closing schools. She made sure the community was front and center to the school board and understood closing schools for undisclosed budget shortfall is not in the interest of long term fiscal responsibility, would obviously not be in the best interest of the children, and not what the community wanted. She now sees the need for leadership that represents the community by being part of the board. A reminder, board members are public servants. Make sure we are electing people that represent us so we can ensure the continued success of Bolton Primary School.
