Updates:

- Lady B: Official statement from BNA regarding the tugboat Lady B was given to city officials.
- McLean House officially listed on the National Register of Historic Places! Party June 28th 11-12:30.
- Laptop: Discussed the possibility of getting a Laptop for BNA use. Option to buy seems the cheapest and easiest option. Discussed different models, and the motion was made and passed to purchase a computer and cap this expense at \$300.

New Business:

- Darren Weiss, City Planning Manager; Waterfront Project: Walked us through the 4 guiding principles of the project and laid out where we are on the project timeline. Idea is ultimately to connect the neighborhoods of Willamette to Bolton through the waterfront. The Vision Plan for the project currently finished, with more open houses to come on July 24th at the Adult Community Center and July 31st at the library. Tentative adoption for the city council is set for November of 2025. Following that, the next phase of the project will look at zoning/codes, design standard, transportation, and public private partnerships.
- **Christi Lanz:** Update that Bolton Preschool has full enrollment for fall. Mandarin program seems to have an arbitrary cap at 18. Possible action for community members wondering why or anyone who would like a reason for this could email WLWV School Board and ask questions or ask them to increase the enrollment numbers.
- Ice Cream Social: Motion made and passed to cap spending budget at a generous \$1000 to cover any unforeseen costs. Suggestion to ask Market of Choice to sponsor to help cut cost. Decision made to invite 1st Responders. Local music Knotty Sangria was booked and Spectator Pizza confirmed to attend and sell pizza (at no cost to BNA).
