#### **Updates**:

- **Bolton Fundraiser:** Motion made passing unanimously to donate \$300 to the Bolton Primary School fundraiser, The Buzz Around.
- **Historic Willamette Main Street, Halloween in Willamette Event:** Approached by the group to invest in this trick or treat event on Main St. event since we don't have any events like this in Bolton and many from our neighborhood participate. Motion made passing 6/9 (3 abstained) to donate \$100 to contribute towards the kids activities and trick or treating in Willamette.
- **Communications Update:** BNA Facebook page up to a new high of 175 followers. New computer up and running for BNA use.
- **BNA City Webpage**: Mission finally accomplished, thanks to Vince Miles and Danielle at the city, to get our annual reports posted from 2019 to present.
- **Bolton Volunteer Garden:** The garden is looking great as Vince has been out working several days a week this past month (with minor contributions by Patrick and Amanda) spreading mulch and taking out a rotten tree stump. The City's Public Works Department donated 7.5 cubic yards of mulch to add to the 8 Vince imported. Encouraged everyone to take a good look as you go by, as the garden is looking great.
- **Ice Cream Social:** Over 130 participants not including guests from the city and local 1st responders. Thanks To Knotty Sangria and Spectator Pizza for coming out and to for everyone who participated, especially Alfred Brown for running out to get more ice cream mid event.

- **Clarifying Language:** Brief discussion about clarifications in the language of the elections process with members asking to add specificity to nomination and voting procedures for BNA officers.
- Christi Lanz WLWV update: Presented sheet with pros and cons to the upcoming proposed Bond measure. Went over distinction between a bond and a levy.

- Caved Pumpkin Contest: PTA and BNA joining forces for the pumpkin contest this year. Bolton PTA has invited us to put out flyer with the Pumpkin Palooza at Bolton where anyone can bring in a carved pumpkin to be judged by lining them out front set in age categories to be voted on by the community. We will provide prizes. Motion made to use our funds for prizes not to exceed \$100 (and we have prize bags from last year to distribute as well.)
