The Meeting was called to order shortly after 7 PM in the Bolton Primary School.

As Saturday November 15 was the beginning of the 5th Annual Lighting of Maddax Woods we discussed this project which included an opportunity to purchase Native plants for yourself or for donating to W.L. Parks for replenishing our parks. If you choose to donate you receive a tax write off and 20% off coupon on your next Bosky Dell purchase. Cut trees with lights and stakes are still available for purchase at \$13. for "Charlie Brown" trees for outdoor bird feeding and \$30. for trees suitable for indoor Christmas trees. The sale of Bird Treets, etc. was last Saturday.

The Wed. November 19 required hearing before the Planning Commission^{for TVF&R} was discussed and also the Thurs. Historic Review meeting. There is a good possibility that the Historic house will be moved to another site. All were encouraged to attend or watch on TV. The first designs and the final designs were passed around so that we could see the evidence of suggestions we made. TVF&R is also working with the Garden Club that wants to donate appropriate roses for the landscaping.

Rob Watson and others from Station 58 came to thank voters for renewing their Bond Measure through 2014 at the last election. Rob also filled us in on the attributes of the new truck they have acquired that will help in negotiating our W.L. hills.

The minutes of the October meeting were approved as printed.

Sgt. Corbin filled us in on recent police activity in Bolton and W.L.. He brought C.D.'s to help people monitor their computers for inappropriate information.

Updates were given on the planning meeting for West Bridge park, replacement of the rest rooms at Hammerle Park and changes to the wading pool and ODOT bridge repair to the W.L.- O.C. bridge which is on schedule and will provide access for pedestrians and bikes during the 6 month to one year closure to begin in 2009.

Our "History Lesson" for the evening was the completion of the naming process for West Linn in 1913.

It was announced that in accordance with our bylaws no December meeting will be held and our next meeting will be January 12 because of the 3rd

Monday holiday on the 19th.

It was announced that the Citizen Advisory Group Chairs and Neighborhood Association Presidents will have a work session with City Council on Dec. 15 to report on the accomplishments, plans and goals for our groups.
