Gail Holmes, Chairperson of the West Linn Historic Resource Advisory Board stated that the board was formed in Jan. 2007 following West Linn's becoming a Certified Local Government. At her first State Board Meeting the State Board felt that the boundries for the Willamette Historical District needed to be expanded and a more detailed description of the town was needed. The W.L. Board is now working on Boltons Holly and Grove Street area and next year will do River St. as state funds become available.
