Summary: This contract is slurry seal of select West Linn roads and for crack sealing treatments prior to application of the slurry seal.

The City is “piggy-backing” on a City of Gresham competitive procurement that contains a provision allowing other Oregon municipalities to utilize their competitive process. The bidding process and results were reviewed and appear reasonable. The contractor is agreeable extending his unit price to the City of West Linn and has requested an escalation provision for price adjustments directly reflecting and protecting the contractor from the volatility of the oil products market. This has also been reviewed by City staff and determined to be reasonable as structured.

This piggy-back arrangement saves the City administrative effort as well as precious time, facilitating application of slurry seal this Fall prior to the arrival of the fall and winter rains.

There is \$2,000,000 included in the FY2009 budget for street maintenance and repair of which this slurry seal and crack sealing effort is a part.

City staff recommends award of the contract to Blackline, Inc.
