The City Council is hosting two community listening sessions regarding the City of West Linn’s upcoming bargaining with the Clackamas County Police Officers’ Association, CCPOA. The purpose of these listening sessions is to increase community engagement and transparency, to inform the public about the collective bargaining process, and to listen to community concerns and obtain feedback regarding police services to ensure the collective bargaining agreement and agency best meets the needs and priorities of the community.

These sessions will be attended by members of City Council, Department Staff, and the City’s labor attorney. Council will be present to receive input, and the City’s labor attorney will be present to answer general questions regarding bargaining process and related law. The sessions will be open meetings using a virtual format. Each session will be one hour, and in order to provide equitable input from all members of the community, participants will be given up to 5 minutes each to give public comment. Topics of input will be limited to police services generally.
