






- The National Community Survey is a benchmarked survey, which helps compare West Linn to over 500 other communities of 50 million residents nationwide
- Our survey was conducted from Aug
 5, 2022, to Sept 23, 2022
- Probability-based sample of 2,800 households
- 684 total responses received
- Results statistically weighted to reflect West Linn overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 4% margin of error


West Linn is a great place to live, especially for families, with strong sense of safety.

- Plan to remain in West Linn for the next 5 years


9 in 10 residents gave excellent or good ratings to:



Percent rated "good" or "excellent"







Residents appreciate many aspects of the City's economy and highlight some potential areas for growth.



Percent rated "good" or "excellent"







While car travel is a strength in West Linn, alternative modes of transportation may present opportunities for growth.

Percent rated "good" or "excellent"






Most survey items

benchmarks.




Room to Grow

Percent rated "good" or "excellent"









Alternate modes of transportation may be an area of potential growth for the City. At least two-thirds of respondents reported having walked or biked in the last year, higher than the national average.

Ratings for ease of travel by bicycle or public transportation were lower than national benchmarks.

Residents value West Linn's utility infrastructure and related services.






Utilities

Almost 75% of respondents positively rated West Linn's utility infrastructure; 87% identified it as a priority.

These ratings were all similar to national averages with the exception of drinking water and stormwater management, which were both rated higher than benchmark comparison communities.






We plan to repeat this survey annually to help us measure change over time
