1. Schedule

- April 11 Council has an executive session at 5:30 pm followed by the regular Council Meeting at 6:30 pm. The executive session may not be necessary and be cancelled. We will know more before Monday night and let you know. The Business Meeting includes the Economic Opportunities Analysis Plan, Mapleton Base Lift Paving Contract, ODOT FASTLANE I-205 Bridge Grant letter of support, and the Damascus IGA. The city manager of Damascus has been informed that we anticipate giving them 30 day notice of cancellation. Clackamas County has also been notified.
- April 18 Work Session includes a disaster preparedness presentation, fees discussion, and Robinwood Station discussion.
