### 1. Call to Order

Evan and Olivia suggest mentioning the insufficiency of any hypothetical future activity buses

Advay suggests mentioning difficulty of bringing instruments on buses

Andrew suggests mentioning that students park illegally anyway, taking the tickets

Olivia points out that typically, taxpaying parents (who pay *property* tax) pay for said tickets

Mentioning inadequacy of any hypothetical future and/or current public transit

Andrew claims that the proposal will probably be popular in the city, but very unpopular in the neighborhood

Advay suggests having lots of parents show up at the City Council proposal
