**COVID-19 Discussion:** Discussion continued on concerns related to Covid-19, particularly at school. Members wanted school to be more upfront about Covid-19 numbers and mask enforcement to be more of a priority for school staff. Details of lunchtime concerns related to

having few spaces to be while eating and drinking unmasked were discussed, these concerns will increase as it gets colder and harder to find safer outdoor or covered places to eat. Members discussed managing their risk by being comfortable around some limited friend groups (you better know their risk level) with masks off for lunch, but needing space from other groups. Solutions such as asking administrators to open classroom space were offered. Liv volunteered to put together a draft letter with Covid-19 concerns and proposed solutions for further YAC consideration at the next meeting.
