Call to Order: Meeting called to order by President Summer at 4:12pm

Summer mentioned that Todd Jones would like to see YAC at more Council meetings and acting in more of an advisory capacity. Liv suggested listing Council meetings on a spreadsheet and getting YAC members to sign up to attend. Summer said the goal would be to have one member at each meeting to get a report, then give input at next meeting. She asked Rory for is thoughts.

Rory asked whether they planned to sit the whole meeting or offer public comment, which is shorter. He invited them to join work sessions, which are quicker. He also suggested that Council should report what they're working on to YAC, then YAC can come to following meeting with suggestions and feedback.

Rory said he will bring this up with Council and hoped to have this system started in May.
