Annamika asks YAC if they have been thinking of pursuing any new objectives and mentions work her and Caroline had done with Youthline, and plan to carry into this year

Discussion of meeting dates in accordance to when council has work session follows-

Quentin asks Rory to clarify when and at what frequency the council meets.

Rory clarifies and says he will bring up YAC on Oct. 3, then YAC members can come to the meeting on Oct. 17 and goals and projects can be finalized.

Annamika offers to go to the first meeting YAC will be scheduled to attend, Quentin also volunteers.

Madeline asks about YAC funds, Nate says \$ doesn't go through YAC, rather the city manages funds as needed. Rory says staff has some expense authority, and Danielle says it has been historically just allocated as needed. Jake uses drug drop off as an example, paying Officer Johnson overtime.

Annamika asks Jake and Nate about their experience going to council meetings, and if they think it would be effective to schedule out people for meetings. Nate says no, easier to go with whoever is available, and Annamika offers to add council meetings as a meeting topic, as to make sure everyone is in the know of who/what is going to council, council's response, etc.

Madeline brings up pitching another skate park down the hill, conversation about the rec center continues until the meeting is adjourned by Annamika.
