**Call to Order:** Meeting called to order by President Annamika at 4:00pm.

## **Project Check-Ins:**

After applying the edits, the YAC unanimously voted to send the letter to ODOT. Danielle suggested having a copy of the letter to present to anyone who asked about it, like the Tidings.

Annamika brought up the community center plan, and due to the council already showing interest, there will likely be little opposition. Madeline was not there and was identified as someone interested in that.

Annamika brought up the communications plan, and Danielle said that have been some snags have been hit with social media training with law enforcement, and so the communication plan will not be able to happen this school year.

**Other Business:** Annamika asked Jake about the student journalist who reached out, and Jake said they did not reach out to him about Oppenlander. Karina asked if Jake knew the name, and he did not.

Jake said he is continuing to work on the drug drop off, and find avenues of advertising the event through the newspaper or Facebook.

With the remaining team, Annamika brought up the YAC application.

Annamika brought up the possibility of a guest speaker, and whether or not we wanted that to be Pam Pearce. Quinton agreed she would be a good option.
