WL Connected: Your Voice. Your Neighborhood.

Get informed. Get involved. Get connected.

This work plan was developed by the Committee for Citizen Involvement (CCI) of the City of West Linn to increase public engagement with local Neighborhood Associations (NAs) and Community Advisory Groups (CAGs).

Month 1: Foundation & Messaging

- Create a simple 'WL Connected' logo or wordmark
- Develop a messaging toolkit (elevator pitch, FAQs explaining NAs vs HOAs)
- Create content templates for social media, newsletters, and flyers
- Assign CCI roles (social media, event booth coordinator, newsletter writer)

Month 2: Awareness Launch

- City newsletter feature about NAs and CAGs
- Run a 2-week social media campaign: 'Did you know you're already part of a Neighborhood Association?'
- Place flyers/posters in libraries, coffee shops, and community centers
- Enhance city website with prominent NA and CAG links and an interactive NA map

Month 3: Community Connection

- Pop-up booths at Farmers Market, Music in the Park, and Movies in the Park
- Host an 'NA Open House Week' where all active NAs invite neighbors to a welcome night

Month 4: Storytelling & Recruitment

- Launch 'Meet Your Neighborhood Leaders' series on social and newsletters
- Recruit volunteers for inactive NAs ('Bring Your NA Back to Life')
- Offer training/onboarding for new board members

Month 5: Celebrate & Recognize

- Declare an NA/CAG Appreciation Month with social media spotlights
- Host a Citywide Community Night with all NAs and CAGs represented

Month 6: Sustain & Measure

- Survey residents about awareness of NAs
- Track metrics: attendance at meetings, new board members, social engagement

• Set next-year goals and continue campaigns
