# **2017 Cleanup Program**

This cleanup program replaces the cleanup week we have held in years past.

# Do I qualify?

- The curbside Personalized Clean-up Day (PCD) is available to residential West Linn customers who reside inside city limits.
- Participating customers must have an active residential account in good standing with West Linn Refuse & Recycling.

# What items can I place out for collection?

Appliances, electronics, mattress sets, furniture, metal items, carpet, or up to 5 cans (must be bagged, boxed, bundled or containerized by the customer). Please see reverse side for acceptable and unacceptable item list.

# How many collections do I get?

- One (1) PCD + access to a free waste drop-off event watch for more information on our drop-off event in early 2017.
- PCD participation guidelines include one (1) of the following:

5 bags or bundles of non-putrescible items (60 lb weight limit each)

**OR** Major appliances — up to 2 large bulky items (see reverse side for restrictions)

OR Bulky — up to 2 large bulky items

**OR** E-Waste — up to 5 items

Additional items may be scheduled for an extra fee.

## When can I schedule a collection?

■ Customers have the 2017 calendar year to schedule their personalized cleanup day. Customers should request their collection 1 week in advance of their regular collection day by calling West Linn Refuse & Recycling at 503-557-3900.






#### **Construction Debris\***

Such as concrete, plaster, or dirt.



#### Oversized Items\*

Such as pianos, hot tubs, etc.



# Tires\*

#### Appliances w/freon\*

Such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners.



#### **Putrescible Solid Waste\***

Household waste of any kind, including kitchen or bathroom trash.



#### **Hazardous Waste**

Such as paints, pesticides, chemicals, household batteries, & cleaning agents.

#### **Furniture**

- Sofas, sofa beds, chairs, futons, dressers, tables.
- Cabinets, bookshelves, desks.
- Other similar household furniture items.



#### **Appliances**


- Washers, dryers, water heaters, stoves, and other large appliances without freon.
- Toaster ovens, and other small appliances.

#### **Electronics**

- TV's, DVD and VCR players, stereo equipment and speakers.
- Computers, monitors, printers and other hardware items.
- Lamps



### Mattresses



All sizes of mattresses, foundations and box springs.

#### Metal

- Bed frames, scrap metal, pipes.
- File cabinets, shelving units.
- Exercise equipment, bikes.

#### **Carpets and Padding**

 Carpets and padding must be rolled or bundled into 6-foot lengths and weigh no more than 60 pounds per bundle.



Long loose items such as lumber, window blinds, pipes, brooms and mops, etc., should be tied into bundles no longer than 6 feet in length and weighing no more than 60 pounds per bundle.
