WEST LINN FOOD PANTRY & MEALS ON WHEELS

West Linn Food Pantry is now providing pre-packed food curbside during their regular business hours from 3:00pm to 6:00pm on Thursdays. You are encouraged to please stay in your vehicle in front of the pantry and they will bring the food to you. You do not need to bring bags or boxes for your food. Donations may be dropped off curbside between 1:00pm and 6:00pm on Thursdays.

WEST LINN PRESCRIPTION DELIVERY

West Linn Police Department employees will provide a free prescription delivery service for West Linn residents. Anyone who is 65 years of age or older, or who has any serious underlying medical condition that would put them at a higher risk of severe illness due to COVID-19, can call the West Linn Police Department at (503) 655-6214 to arrange for prescription delivery from local West Linn pharmacies.
