City of West Linn Awarded the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting

CHICAGO - The Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting has been awarded to City of West Linn by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for its comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR). The Certificate of Achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting, and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management.

An Award of Financial Reporting Achievement has been awarded to the individual(s), department or agency designated by the government as primarily responsible for preparing the award-winning CAFR. This has been presented to: Finance Department, City of West Linn. The CAFR has been judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program including demonstrating a constructive "spirit of full disclosure" to clearly communicate its financial story and motivate potential users and user groups to read the CAFR. GFOA is a nonprofit professional association serving approximately 17,500 government finance professionals with offices in Chicago, IL, and Washington, D.C. ###

Jass Two started in 1994 when famous Portland bandleader Teddy Deane of the Swingline Cubs and The Holy Modal Rounders called Steve Boden to work the Columbia River sternwheelers. They were featured talent aboard the "Queen of the West" and the "Columbia Gorge." They also played corporate, convention and casual engagements. The group continues today under the leadership of Steve Boden to play hot and swing jazz with master reedman Dick Saunders and bassist John Walling (John is the "plus one").
