### About Johnny Limbo & the Lugnuts

Starting as a party gag in 1978, "Johnny Limbo & The Lugnuts" have become one of the most popular bands to perform the classic hits from the 50's and 60's. The Lugnuts fame spread beyond the Pacific Northwest, dazzling audiences from Washington State to Washington, D.C. Their performances have been enthusiastically received at civic celebrations, fairs, fund raisers, concert halls, conventions and televised events. The nine member band includes a knockout horn section that really swings on tunes from Memphis to Motown, and a female vocalist, allowing the band to feature many of the talented ladies of rock. In addition to the great music, the show features colorful costuming and energetic choreography which always brings rave reviews.
