West Linn Breaks Ground for New Police Station on 8th Avenue

The West Linn City Council took part in a ground breaking ceremony for the new West Linn Police Station on Monday, September 9, 2013. From left to right, Councilor Thomas Frank, Councilor Jody Carson, Mayor John Kovash, Councilor Jenni Tan, and Council President Mike Jones joined a crowd of Steering Committee members, police officers, and community members at this exciting event.

"It has been a long time," Mayor John Kovash said, thanking everyone for their help on the project before digging his ceremonial shovel into the site at 1800 - 8th Avenue. "It has taken the cooperation of an awful lot of the good citizens of West Linn, the police department, staff and the City Council."

Voters approved an \$8.5 million bond measure in 2011 to replace the current police station, which was built next to the Arch Bridge in 1936. Follow the construction project on the City's Facebook page at Facebook.com/CityOfWestLinn.

Oregon Metro Grants \$220,000 to City of West Linn for Arch Bridge Project

Oregon Metro granted the City of West Linn \$220,000 for Arch Bridge area master planning efforts. At the Monday, September 9, 2013 City Council meeting, Metro Councilor Carlotta Collette presented Mayor John Kovash and the West Linn City Council with a commemorative check for the project.

The planning area, which is adjacent to I-205 and the Arch Bridge, was identified as a "town center" in the Metro 2040 Concept Plan. West Linn's planning efforts are designed to coalesce with Oregon City's Willamette Falls Legacy Project, a vision and master plan for the former Blue Heron paper mill.
