

FAQ: Parks Maintenance Fee Increase

How much is the increase?

The increase is \$5.20 per household, per month starting March 1, 2026.

Why was it increased?

To fund the Parks share of the new Operations Center.

How is the rest of the Operations Center funded?

Through existing Public Works fees and resources already in place—no additional increase is required for that portion.

What is the Operations Center?

A facility that supports Parks and Public Works staff, equipment, and daily operations—helping the City maintain parks and infrastructure more efficiently.

What does the Parks Maintenance fee pay for?

- Landscaping and mowing
- Playground and equipment upkeep
- Restroom cleaning and repairs
- Maintenance of trails, fields, and courts
- Irrigation and general maintenance
- Staff support
