Officer' Report:

Treasure's Report: Balance at end of April was \$8,071.99 with deposit of \$60 credit from City of West Linn new balance is \$8,131.99

Ivy Task Force Update: Eleanor Wynn, provided the attached document as a summary of her research on ivy abatement in the Trillium Creek Green Space. (see attachment)

Emergency Preparedness/Map Your Neighborhood: Dede Montgomery presented information about how to participate in the Map Your Neighborhood program. She provided the contact info for Judy Wiechmann ([Joody.w@comcast.net](mailto:Joody.w@comcast.net)) and Kris Duncan ([kduncanarms@gmail.com](mailto:kduncanarms@gmail.com)) of the West Linn Public Safety Advisory Board. These two women and one additional person are available to come to your home and present the materials to you and your neighbors to get the ball rolling in your emergency preparedness plan. It is recommended that a group of 12 to 15 households be included in each neighborhood gathering. Patti Niswanger agreed to hold a meeting for her neighbors in order to be better equipped to talk to other neighbors about hosting their own meeting.

New Business or Topics of Interest: resident expressed concern about yard debris being dumped on the horse trail between Pimilico and Appaloosa Way. Resident will identify which neighbors are doing this so a notice can be provided to discontinue this practice.

Pedestrian Access – concerns expressed in regards to improving of the crosswalk on Santa Anita at Country Club, adding a sidewalk at on Hidden

Springs at Carriage Way for people wishing to access the Palomino Trail, and improving pedestrian access on Pimlico from Hwy 43 to Palomino Way.
