

Hidden Springs Neighborhood Association
West Linn, Oregon
Minutes May 18, 2004

The meeting was called to order by Al Belais, President at 7:05pm. In attendance were 13 members of the community

The minutes of the April 20th meeting were corrected to include a motion that was passed to link the club website to www.cheappower.com. They were then approved as corrected with the addition of a motion that was made and passed in April to put a link on the web site to www.cheappower.com.

There was a discussion about a web site for the Neighborhood Association. Lynn Lytle said that she would go to the city and see about having them place web pages on the city server about Hidden Springs and have them place a link to the external web site www.cheappower.com.

The Cleanup day on May 15th was a resounding success, especially due to the time and efforts put in by the officers and volunteers. Four very large garbage bins were completely filled to the brim.

Dave Adams, a resident of the stafford triangle area discussed metro plans for the Stafford triangle area including Borland North and Borland South. He is a member of the "Stafford-Tualatin Valley CPO" that is organized to work with Metro to provide a viable solution to the area. There was much discussion about growth in the triangle area and other areas around West Linn.

Lynn was thanked for her work in purchasing 4 signs to be placed around Hidden Springs to announce meetings. She is planning on placing them on the Friday before each meeting and then taking them in after the meeting.

Old Business was discussed. There is a School Board committee which was not present to report. The City report on the traffic studies was not available either. Lynn Lytle talked to John Atkins about a reallocation of funds for the larger Neighborhood Associations, and was told there was no plans to fund the Neighborhood Associations other than \$1500 per year. Al Belais wrote a letter to the city about the debris on the Bridal Trail area, but has not received any response yet.

There was much discussion on whether to hold meetings every month, just as needed, or taking the summer off and resuming in the fall. A motion was made and carried to meet on June 15th and decide at that time whether to meet over the summer.

The next meeting will be June 15th at 7pm at the Adult Community Center if it is available.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:41pm.
