Thursdays @ 10 am on Facebook Live

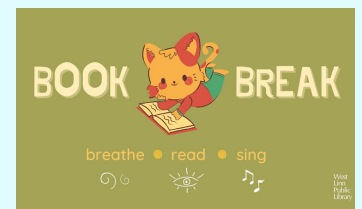
Your storytime librarians will share stories and songs that promote early literacy skills. Please note you do not need a Facebook account to access Virtual Storytime.

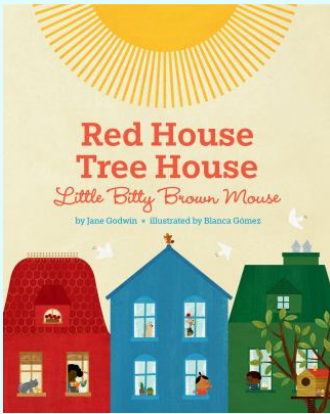

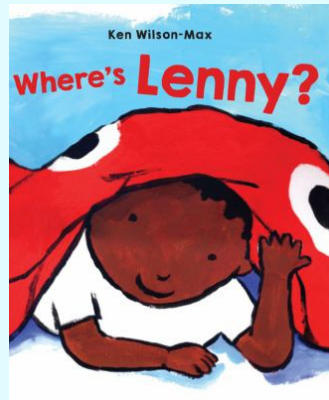

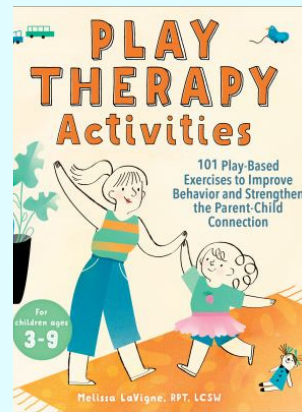
**Red House Tree House

Kids will love the whimsical, rhyming picture book that is sure to be a modern classic --but most of all, they'll love looking for the little bitty brown mouse!



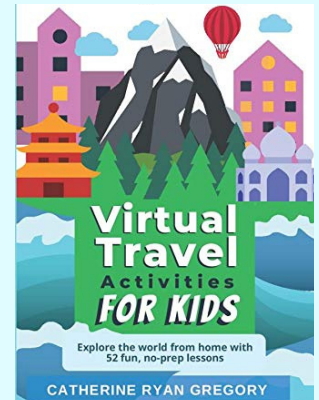
**Where's Lenny?**
