This feminist fantasy reimagining of the Snow
White fairytale traces the relationship of two
young women who are doomed to be rivals.
Only one can win all, while the other must
lose everything--unless both can find a way to
reshape themselves and their story.

ITwo hundred years after Cinderella found her prince, the fairy tale is over. Teen girls are now required to appear at the Annual Ball, where the men of the kingdom select wives based on a girl's display of finery. If a suitable match is not found, the girls not chosen are never heard from again. Sophia would much rather marry Erin, her childhood best friend, than parade in front of suitors. Together with Constance, the last known descendant of Cinderella and her step sisters, Sophia vows to bring down the king once and for all.

House of Salt and Sorrows

In a manor by the sea, twelve sisters are cursed. Annaleigh lives a sheltered life at Highmoor with her sisters and their father and stepmother. Once there were twelve, but loneliness fills the grand halls now that four of the girls' lives have been cut short. Each death was more tragic than the last--the plague, a plummeting fall, a drowning, a slippery plunge--and there are whispers throughout the surrounding villages that the family is cursed by the gods.

In 1424 Hamlin, Katerina reluctantly allies

In this adaptation of the fairy tale Snow

woods, who, along with other brave friends,
help Sophie overcome the story's true villain
and reclaim her throne.

Cinder and Glass

Melissa de la Cruz (T DE LA CRUZ, M)
Cendrillon de Louvois was poised to be the
most eligible maiden in all of France. But the
death of her father, the king's favorite
advisor, has left Cendrillon at the will of her
cruel stepmother and stepsisters.
Dubbed Lady Cinder by the court, Cendrillon is
forced to become a servant to her new family.
But when she attends the royal ball, she
catches the eye of the handsome Prince Louis
and his younger brother, Auguste.

A Curse So Dark and Lonely

Brigid Kemmerer (T KEMMERER, B)
Harper, a high school senior with cerebral
palsy, gets abducted while trying to thwart a
kidnapping in Washington, D.C. She awakes at
Ironrose Castle in Emberfall, where a
vengeful enchantress, Lilith, has cursed
Prince Rhen and his guard, Commander Grey,
to continually relive the autumn of Rhen's
18th year. Every three months, unless he
finds love, Rhen becomes a monster who kills
indiscriminately.

Cornered by the wicked
Erlking on the night of the
wild hunt, Serilda claims
that she can spin straw into
gold, a lie that saves her life
but lands her in the Erlking's
castle on the next full moon
with a room full of straw and
an impossible task.
Fortunately, Gild, an impish

(and attractive) poltergeist shows up, offering help in exchange for Serilda's golden necklace. Gild easily fulfills his end of the bargain and does so a second time for Serilda's ring; when the Erlking makes the third demand, however, Serilda has nothing left to give Gild, and the romance that has sparked between them only complicates things further.



These Feathered Flames

Alexandra Overy (T OVERY, A)

When twin heirs are born in

Tourin, their fates are
decided at a young age. While

Izaveta remained at court to
learn the skills she'd need as
the future queen, Asya was
taken away to train with her
aunt, the mysterious Firebird,

who ensured magic remained balanced in the realm. But before Asya's training is completed, the ancient power blooms inside her, which can mean only one thing: the queen is dead, and a new ruler must be crowned.

Don't Call the Wolf

Aleksandra Ross (T ROSS, A)

A fierce young queen, neither human nor lynx, who fights to protect a forest humans have long abandoned. An exhausted young soldier, last of his name, who searches for the brother who disappeared beneath those trees without a trace. A Golden Dragon, fearsome and vengeful, whose wingbeats haunt their nightmares and their steps. When these three paths cross at the fringes of a war between monsters and men, shapeshifter queen and reluctant hero strike a deal that may finally turn the tide against the rising hordes of darkness.

Historian Filore Nenroa and lady "huntsman" Shane Ragnall are teen treasure hunters, each doomed by curse or circumstance to wander far from their homes. While exploring magical ruins, Fi pricks her finger on a spindle and discovers that she is destined to wake Briar Rose, the

beautiful sleeping prince who seems to have stepped straight out of shōjo manga. Meanwhile, Shane meets Red, a mysterious and enthralling young woman who keeps popping up at just the right moments. Looming over their journey is the Spindle Witch, who cursed Briar Rose and his fallen kingdom.
