
Kate Messner (YT MESSNER)

Zetta Elliott (YT ELLIOTT, Z) When punk rock-loving JJ Pankowski and graffiti artist Pie Velez stumble into an unlikely friendship, they use their love of music and art to get through a tough semester until a run-in with the police changes everything.

Kaija Langley (YT LANGLEY, K) Eleven-year-old April must come to terms with the sudden death of her best friend, Zee.



A Place at the Table Saadia Faruqi (YT FARUQI) Sixth-graders Sara, a Pakistani American, and Elizabeth, a Jewish girl, connect in an after school cooking club and bond over food and their mothers' struggles to become United States citizens.

Mai K. Nguyen (YT GN NGUYEN)


Willow, who has been struggling with her emotions since her mother's death, runs away into the woods and meets Pilu, a lost tree spirit who cannot find her way back home.
